

What is your task?

Your task is to participate in the work and to contribute by sharing and developing knowledge within the working group's work area.

What is expected of you?

You are expected to participate actively. This means that, to the extent possible, you should attend about two meetings annually (e.g. by web) and respond to emails between meetings.

During a period, minor tasks may need to be carried out in connection with the organisation of technical trips, seminars and the like, which the members will resolve jointly in the working group.

· What do you do get out of it?

You get access to a lot of knowledge. You also get a strong network in your specific work area that you can draw on in your daily work. You enhance your CV.

What does your company get out of it?

Your company gets access to knowledge, including knowledge about new markets, methods, best practices, etc. as well as unique skills development.

Which meetings are you expected to attend?

You are expected to attend about two working group meetings annually (e.g. by web).

• For how long will you be a member of the working group?

It depends on the period for which the working group has been set up, but not more than four years, since the period ends in June 2024.
