### Corresponding members

As a new measure during this period (2020-2024), NVF will start accepting corresponding members.

Being a corresponding member means that you participate in the activities of the working group by correspondence, without formal agreement to attend meetings, (although attendance of corresponding members at working group meetings whenever possible is welcomed).

- **What is your task?**  
Your task is - by email - to participate in the activities of the working group.
- **What is expected of you?**  
You are expected to participate actively, but only by email.
- **What do you do get out of it?**  
You get access to knowledge and best practices within your field.
- **What does your company get out of it?**  
Your company gets access to the written knowledge shared in the working group.
- **Which meetings are you expected to attend?**  
You are not expected to attend any meetings, but you can attend meetings whenever possible.
- **For how long will you be a member of the working group?**  
It depends on the period for which the working group has been set up, but not more than four years, since the period ends in June 2024.
- **Do you get paid for your work?**  
No, you do not get any payment for your work.
