


Killed and seriously injured on motorcycle and moped





Motorcyclist's share - total number of killed and seriously injured


Andel av de drepte og hardt skadde som er på mellomtung eller tung MC






Indicator targets for motorcycle- and moped drivers 2018-2021

A 30 % reduction in the risk of being killed or seriously injured for motorcycle and moped drivers per kilometre driven

- 24 measures




The target of the strategy

ABS-bremser redder MC-førere 23.11.2018

Mye tyder på at blokkeringsfrie bremser (ABS-bremser) tjener sin misjon også for motorsyklister. I Sverige har antallet MC-førere som har «bremsa seg på trynet» blitt halvert siden 2015.

Selv om ABS-bremser på MC har blitt svært vanlig på motorsykler i dette årtusen,



var det først i 2016 det i Europa ble påbudt med ABS-bremser på MC over 126 kubikk. Allerede nå kan en svensk studie konkludere med at ABS-bremser har mye å si for sikkerheten til motorsyklister.

Bransjeorganisasjonen for svenske forsikringsselskap, Sveda, og NMCUs søsterorganisasjon Sveriges MotorCyclister (SMC) har nylig offentliggjort en studie som viser at svenske motorsyklister de siste tre årene har halvert antallet som har gått over ende som følge av nedbremsing. Results (part 1)



168 killed and seriously injured in driving off the road accidents from 2015-2017

Where?

- County roads (64 %) and national roads (24 %)
- 69 % of the accidents happened in **outer curves**
- Most frequently: driving off the road on the right side in a left curve

When?

- Summer
- Daytime

Age?

- About 50 % age **25-54 years**
- Age **45-54 years** dominates

Driving conditions?

- 137 accidents on dry roads
- 4 accidents on snow/ice and slippery roads



33 fatal accidents

Causes and explanations Several explanations for each accident

- High speed 21 accidents
- Irresponsible behaviour 13 accidents (speed, intoxicated driving, no licence, unregistrated motorcycle...)
- Intoxicated driving 9 accidents (8 of those also combined with high speed)
- **Techical issues** 16 accidents (minor problems)
- Conditions related to the road and the line of sight 7 accidents
- **Positioning in curves** 4 accidents
- Elements along the roadside (rocks, trees...) 9 accidents
