
## Objectives for the plan period 2021-2030

# Objective for police registered casualties in 2030

- Max. 90 killed (2020: 163)
- Max. 900 seriously injured (2020: 1716)
   (reduction 50% in relation to average 2017-19)

# Objective for injured registered in Danish National Patient Registry 2030

Max. 10.000 slightly injured






## Key Performance Indicators (KPI)

KPI:s are indicators that the commission will follow as they have a clear correlation to a reduction in accidents and casualties.

- KPI:s can serve as "warning light" by indicating an undesired tendency before this can be seen in number of killed and injured
- Can also be used to explain a positive or negative change in accidents and/or casualties
- KPI:s will also be used in EU
- ...and also in Sweden and Norway etc.
- Municipalities, organizations and companies can use their own KPI:s



### The Danish Commission has selected these KPI:s



## Focus areas for the period 2021-2030

#### Single vehicle accidents

Many killed and seriously injured in rural areas

#### Head-on collisions

 Many killed and seriously injured on rural roads

#### Accidents in intersections

- Many killed and seriously injured in general
- Especially cyclists in urban areas and motor vehicle drivers in rural areas

#### Vulnerable road users

- Many killed and seriously injured pedestrians
- Many seriously injured cyclists in intersections

#### Young car drivers

 Involved in many serious accidents in relation to their number and kilometers driven



## Measures to obtain the objective, in 6 categories

1. Teaching and communication 19 measures

2. Road design and traffic management 7 measures

3. Legislation, sanction and control 10 measures

4. Vehicles and safety equipment 3 measures

5. Accident data 4 measures

6. Research and cooperation 8 measures




# Vejdirektoratet – measures for state roads

#### **Roads in Denmark**

State roads 3 900 km Municipal roads 70 000 km Private roads 10 000 km

## Vejdirektoratet – measures for state roads







- Increased use of differentiated speed limits
- Road safety measures on rural roads and on roads in urban areas
- Operation and maintenance with increased focus on road safety
- Targeted safety improvements on the state road network



## Vejdirektoratet – measures for the sector

- The municipalities' power to set local speed limits in urban areas
- Increased speed control with Automatic Traffic Control (ATC/ATK)
- Traffic accidents in one single accident register/database
- Systematized and updated traffic accident registration with the police
- Black spot identification 2.0 based on a broader data base than police data
- Digital speed limit map
- Knowledge of behavior and interaction between vulnerable road users and infrastructure
- New road safety knowledge, use of it and ensuring that it is continuously improved
- Handbook: Municipal traffic safety plans
